Dear colleagues and friends,

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to the Seventeenth International Saga Conference which will take place in Reykjavík and Reykholt on 12–17 August 2018.

In this first circular we would like to draw your attention to the main themes of the conference and direct you to the conference website <u>http://www.sagaconference2018.hi.is</u> where, in due course, all information regarding the conference will be made available.

The overarching theme of the conference is 'ÍSLENDINGA SQGUR' but we also mean to use the programme to mark the 900th anniversary of Iceland's first written lawcode. We have therefore chosen four main thematic strands:

Saga Origins and Media Artistry Ideas and Worldview 'Með logum skal land byggja'.

In addition to conventional papers, the programme will include plenary papers, poster presentations, and seminars related to each of the main themes in which participants will be asked to debate particular topics.

The conference will be held at the University of Iceland in Reykjavík, with one full day (Tuesday) of sessions taking place at Reykholt in Borgarfjörður. The programme on Thursday will be devoted to organised excursions. We also intend to offer a two-day post-conference tour to Húnavatnssýsla and Skagafjörður on the 18th–19th of August, if there is enough demand.

Registration for the conference will be in the hands of the conference company CP Reykjavík, which will also assist participants with finding accommodation.
